

Did you know?

In South Carolina...

- Vehicle crashes are the leading cause of violent deaths
- One traffic accident occurs every 5 minutes
- One traffic fatality occurs every 8 hours
- In 2004, 18-year olds had a 78% fatal involvement rate
- In 2006, 15-24 age group was involved in an accident every 11 minutes

Nationally...

- Vehicle accidents are the leading cause of death among teens and young children
- Every 12 minutes someone in America is killed in an accident; every 13 seconds someone is injured
- Accidents are the leading cause of death for Hispanics ages 1-34
- Accidents are the second leading cause of death for African-American males age 15-24
- In 2007, 16-year olds had 54% fatal involvement rate
- In 2007, 18-year olds had a 56% fatal involvement rate
- In 2007, persons 20-24 had a 51% fatal involvement rate

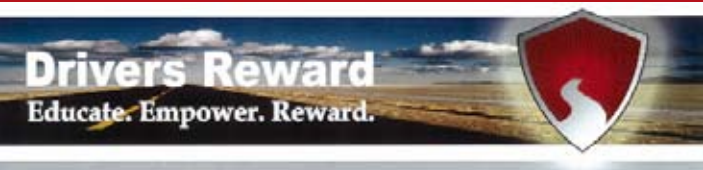
